

Installing Zenith u-he Zebra2 MIDI Map

Due to u-he plugins not having an import MIDI map option, you will have to replace the default MIDI map.

1. Go to the data folder of Zebra2.

By default, (unless installed elsewhere) on MacOS this folder should be in “~/Library/Application Support/u-he/Zebra2/Support” and on Windows in “C:\Users\username\Documents\u-he\Zebra2\Support”.

If you don't know where this folder is located you can launch Zebra2 and click on the patches tab, then right click a preset then select “open in explorer/reveal in finder”.



This will point to the “presets” folder which is in the “u-he\Zebra2\Presets\Zebra2” folder. Navigate to “u-he\Zebra2\Support” folder by going up two folders.

2. Copy and paste the “com.u-he.Zebra2.midiassign.txt” file that’s provided within the “MIDI Maps/u-he Zebra2 MIDI Map” folder in the Zenith archive to the “Support” folder of Zebra2.
